OUR PROGRAM

The Bearcat program is an all inclusive program that begins with a Fall Ball season, short break around Thanksgiving and then back in the gym beginning early November. Our offseason consists of Strength and Conditioning programs for all age groups. We start a minimum of 3 days a week in November.

Aside from the 3 sessions with your team, Position training for Outfielders, Infielders and Catchers are also included. Speed training is another session that begins in January and is included in your fee.

Training doesn't stop there! We have a resident Tutor available to players on weekends to ensure school remains a focus. Drop in sessions support players when they need it. Mental game seminars, nutritional talks and college placement/recruiting all come with the Bearcat experience.

If that's not enough Baseball for you, all of our Instructors offer Private and Semi-Private training in the skills you want.

THE SEASON

Our organisation plays in the Premier Baseball League of Ontario and the New Balance Future Stars Series. Each age division is set up differently with anywhere from 6 - 9 teams at each age group. Teams can expect 24-28 regular season games played in May and June.

Practices continue through season with Instructor led, Live AB's and a strategy session with your coaching staff. Plan for 2-3 per week throughout the outdoor season. (May - Early August)

Tournament season begins in July where each team will participate in a minimum of 2 U.S. tournaments, potentially in province events along with the PBLO Championship weekend in late July. A unique part of the Bearcats Elite program is that we do not stop at the end of July. Our 15 and 18u teams qualify for Provincial elimination draws. Younger players can be asked to support these rosters as we push for National Championships in early August.

PROGRAM COST

Our program continues to grow but we are proud that we can offer the best of everything and much more than other programs at an affordable rate for a true 12 month Elite Program. Our age group fees range from 13u - \$5300 to 18u \$6450. Partnering our teams with The Yard, we leverage revenue streams at our facility to help keep program cost

affordable compared to other regional programs. Competing programs offer much less without a building of their own or similar High level technology at program costs north of \$7800 -\$12,000 (16u cost comparison within the region)

Rosters can be expected to 16 players along with "Pitcher Only" players. (15u Major and above) Our hope with the reduced program cost, is that it allows for players to add additional events such as Spring Training, College Trip and Combine events, and add additional personal training with our professional instructors while putting some aside for College!!
